

Positive Behaviours for Learning

In 2020, Mount Carmel Catholic College will be implementing the Positive Behaviours for Learning Model (PB4L). Positive Behaviour for Learning is a whole school community approach for creating a positive, safe and supportive school climate in which students can learn and develop. Students will be taught the appropriate positive behaviours for different areas in the college under the following headings:

- Be respectful
- Be responsible
- Be safe.
